ITINERARY:

Day 1 – Darwin to Kakadu (LD)

7:00am pick up from your Darwin accommodation. Travel across the Marrakai floodplains of the Adelaide River and on into Kakadu. Learn about the important wetland habitats as we visit Mamukala. View ancient Aboriginal rock art at **Ubirr** and take in the spectacular scenery as we climb atop the rocky outcrop for majestic views of the Arnhemland sandstone plateau. Join the **Guluyambi Cultural cruise** on the East Alligator River to gain an amazing insight into local customs and dreamtime stories from the local Indigenous guide. We may even see a few Crocodiles! Travel to our overnight campsite.



Day 2 – Kakadu (BLD)

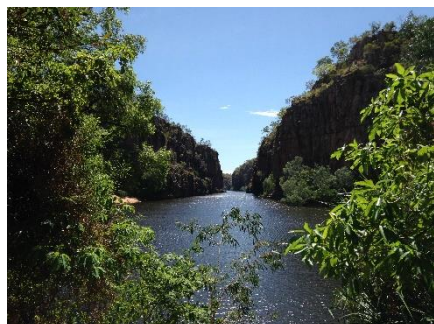
Time for a spot of real 4 Wheel driving today as we travel to **Jim Jim and Twin Falls**. After crossing the Jim Jim creek, we arrive at Twin Falls and cruise through the gorge, admiring the towering escarpment from the sandy beach. Arriving at Jim Jim Falls, walk through the monsoon forest and enjoy an invigorating swim in the plunge pool. Late afternoon we make our way back to our campsite.

Day 3 – Kakadu (BLD)

This morning we visit **Warradjan Cultural Centre** before making our way to the southern region of the Park. Visit one of our favourite waterfalls, **Maguk (Barramundi Gorge)**. Nestled amongst the sandstone escarpment at the end of a paperbark lined creek. The rock pools above and the plunge pool below the falls provide a refreshing swim option. Arriving at **Gunlom** we hike to the top of the falls for a swim in the renowned 'Infinity' pool and watch another breathtaking sunset. A quick scramble back down the ridge before it gets too dark and enjoy another hearty meal.

Day 4 – Kakadu to Katherine (BLD)

After breaking camp, enjoy a refreshing swim in the **Gunlom** plunge pool before setting off towards Katherine. Exiting Kakadu from the south we call in at the old gold mining town of **Pine Creek** and take in some of its history. We continue towards Katherine and detour into the northern sector of Nitmiluk National Park, for a walk and swim at **Edith Falls**. Continue through to Katherine for our afternoon **Top Didge Cultural Tour**. Late afternoon set up camp at Nitmiluk Gorge.



Day 5 – Katherine to Litchfield (BLD)

This morning there are a couple of options for you! Note these options must be decided at time of reservation as canoes are limited.

Option 1: 2Hr Nit Nit Dreaming Gorge Cruise - discover the cultural significance of the first 2 gorges to the traditional landowners - the Jawoyn people. Enjoy a journey of discovery through the magnificent Nitmiluk Gorge. Free time for other optional activities such as hiking to lookout or helicopter ride. **Cruise cost covered in tour price.**

Option 2: Half Day Canoeing - View the 1st Gorge by Boat transfer to the 2nd gorge. Explore the 2nd gorge by canoe for a couple of hours before returning via boat transfer. **Canoeing is covered in tour price.**

After lunch we travel back north towards Litchfield to our last night's camp.

Day 6 – Litchfield to Darwin – (BL)

A Short drive to **Litchfield National Park** this morning so we beat the crowds and explore, relax and swim in some fantastic easily accessible waterfalls. A fantastic way to finish off our Top End expedition. We return you to your Darwin accommodation around 5pm. (Saturday departures may get back a little earlier, so you can check in and get down to the **Mindil Beach** sunset Markets).

General Information and Packing List for 6 Day Top End Expedition

Tour Includes:

- Pick up and drop off from All Darwin accommodation.
 - **Have you advised us of your Hotel address?**
- All meals (as indicated in tour details) & fresh drinking water.
 - **Have you advised us of any Allergies or Dietary restrictions?**
- Basic **Camping** at managed campgrounds.
 - **Showers and Toilet facilities available.**
 - Camping gear provided includes high density foam mattress.

 - **Have you advised us if you need a Sleeping Bag?**
 - **There is no AC power at campsites:**

What to bring:

- Medium backpack, soft bag or suitcase containing:
 - change of clothes for 6 days,
 - Include at least 1 long sleeve shirt/jacket and 1 long pants for cool evenings and mosquito protection.
 - personal toiletries & medicines.
 - **Please limit to 10-15kg maximum.**
 - **This will be stored in vehicle and not readily accessible during the day.**
- Daypack containing:
 - Sunscreen, Insect repellent, bathers, towel & Water bottle (approx. 1.5l).
 - Camera & extra batteries, Hat.
- Sturdy walking shoes.
- Sleeping Bag & Pillow. (Sleeping bags available for hire: \$10)
- Small Torch/ flashlight.
- **Personal Refreshments**
 - Note due to our early departure and nowhere to purchase alcohol in Kakadu, **you will need to purchase any beverages you may desire for the first 3 days prior to departure in Darwin.**

- Kakadu 4WD Safaris has a **100% cancellation fee** for all cancellations made **72 hours** prior to departure. Failure to board constitutes No Refund.

- Excess baggage should be stored at your Darwin accommodation.
- It is your responsibility to contact Kakadu 4WD Safaris with your accommodation pick up point.
- Please advise if you have any special dietary requirements or medical conditions (including allergies) well ahead of departure.
- Travel insurance is compulsory for all international travellers on all tours.
